


Synopsis








Logline

-AFRIMI

Afrim (45 y.o.) is Elira's brother, a man of honor and tradition, very successful in life.

But he is impulsive. Afrim, being a man of tradition, still can't accept the fact that his sister has run from home, he feels let down by her. And this is why he hesitates to help Elira when she needs him the most.



-RRONI

Rron (10 y.o.) is Elira's and Bekim's son, who is raised to be a well mannered boy in a family full of violence.

He spends most of his time playing video games, with headphones on, as a way to escape his parents' constant fighting and arguing.

He is happy only when he sees his parents getting along and together.

Otherwise he locks himself in his room to play video games.



-BEKIMI

Bekim (35 y.o.) is Elira's husband, a man that has lost his path in life. He was a good husband to Elira in the beginning, but later on he develops a gambling addiction, and causes a lot of problems for Elira. He is a cowardly man, who is constantly violent towards Elira. He is a bad father and a worse husband.





Director's Statement

'Left Outside' is a film about the fate of a woman that is an outcast to her own family, she is an outcast to society. It's about the struggle a woman is put through only to have her voice heard so that she is not all forgotten.

This film follows the story of a woman named Elira, who is left outside in the streets without a home to go to.

Her family has their backs turned on her because she has brought shame to them by running away from home and marrying someone that she loved, someone that her family was against. Her parents make it clear to her that if she chooses to marry that man that they forbid, she may never go back to her family ever again. She decides to choose her husband over her family, and that choice turns out to haunt her and that decision becomes a nightmare for her. Her husband gradually starts getting in trouble, starts gambling, and frequently disappears for a couple of days leaving her and their son home alone. Until one day when he disappears, some men show up to her apartment door, and claim that her apartment now belongs to them and kick her out in the street. She is left now with one choice, to go back to her family for help.
